The Village of Akron has made every effort to provide comprehensive solid waste services at a reasonable cost, to village residents.

Services include:

Regular weekly curbside trash pickup.

Bi-weekly curbside pickup of recyclables.

Monthly pick up of bulky items, metal and white goods.

Regular weekly curbside pick up of brush and yard waste (April through November)

Yard waste compost site, available for residents to drop off yard waste and brush (April through November)

Curbside leaf pick up during October and November.

Christmas tree pick up.

REFUSE.....

The Village has contracted with [Modern Corporation](#) for refuse and recyclables to be picked up. Your trash will be picked up at the curb every Friday. When there is an observed holiday during the week, pick up will be on Saturday.

Your trash should be placed at the curb in standard sized garbage cans or plastic bags. Trash should be set out no sooner than 6:00 pm on Thursday evening and empty containers should be removed from the curb before 11:00 pm on Friday.

DO INCLUDE: Household trash and garbage small furniture items (**no metal**)

DO NOT INCLUDE: Large furniture, metal, building material, rubble, recyclables or yard waste.

RECYCLABLES...

Will be picked up on a every other week recycling schedule (A or B) as provided from Modern Corporation. Additional maps/schedules can be obtained at the Village Hall or on our website.

Your recyclables should be placed at the curb in your [Recycling Cart](#). Your [Recycling Cart](#) should be set out no sooner than 6:00 pm on Thursday evening and the empty container taken in by 11:00 pm on Friday.

DO INCLUDE: Newspapers, magazines, phone books, catalogs, bound books, junk mail, brown paper bags, corrugated cardboard (remove tape, staples and strapping), shoe boxes, cereal boxes (waxed paper or foil removed), clear glass jars and bottles, plastic containers (#1 thru #7), aluminum & steel tin cans, kitchen cookware, office papers.

NOTE: plastic, metal & glass containers must be clean—labels do not have to be removed. Cardboard boxes must be broken down in 3' x 3' sections.

DO NOT INCLUDE: Styrofoam containers/packing, garbage, propane tanks, paint cans, medical waste/syringes, flammable liquids, household cleaners, chemicals (dry or liquid), wood items, concrete, garden hoses, electrical cords, clothing or rags, plastic bags, or yard waste.

BULKY ITEMS & WHITE GOODS

Curbside pick up of bulky items, white goods:

Residents may put out **one** bulky or white goods item with their weekly trash and recyclables.

Such as: Appliances, mattress and box springs, large furniture items and metal.

Appliances with FREON will be picked up on the last Friday of the month.

***Homeowners are asked to call the Village Hall before Wednesday of that week at 542-9636, before placing the appliances at the curb so we can notify Modern Corporation.**

TIRES....

There is no curbside pick up for tires. The **Town of Newstead** conducts an annual tire drop off, scheduled on April 29th, 2017 from 9:00 am till Noon. As a resident of the Village, you are entitled to participate in the program. You must first obtain an identification card at the Village Hall. You will be allowed to drop off up to six tires.

COMPOST SITE....

Village residents may bring their yard waste and brush (**no trash**) to the Yard Waste Composting Site, at **12707 Clarence Center Road** which is open, weather permitting, on **Saturdays April 15, 2017 through November 18, 2017 from 9:00 am until Noon.**

Wood Chips and compost are available at the site for village residents to take for their own use at no cost. Residents must load it themselves.

YARD WASTE....

Village crews will pick up yard waste at the curb, on **Mondays, from April 10, 2017 until October 16, 2017.** If Monday is a holiday, pick up will be on Tuesday.

Yard waste should be placed at the curb in **open top containers with handles, weighing no more than 60 pounds. Do not use plastic bags for yard waste.**

Yard waste containers should be set out no later than 7:00 am on Monday but no sooner than 6:00 pm on Sunday and taken in by 11:00 pm on Monday.

DO INCLUDE: Grass clippings, tree and shrub trimmings, leaves and weeds.

DO NOT INCLUDE: Garbage, trash, animal waste or building materials.

DO NOT USE RECYCLABLE CARTS!

BRUSH....

Brush will be chipped at the curb and taken away, by Village crews, on **Mondays, from April 10, 2017, until October 16, 2017.** If Monday is a holiday, it will be picked up on Tuesday.

When putting brush out for pick up, please remember that it will be chipped at the curb. It should be cut to manageable, but not short, lengths and must be **6** inches in diameter or smaller. It is very helpful if brush is stacked neatly at the curb rather than piled. Tree stumps should be put to the side not in the pile of brush.

DO INCLUDE

Limbs and small trees **6** inches in diameter and smaller.

DO NOT INCLUDE

Small diameter brush and vines (this is yard waste), limbs or trees larger than **6** inches in diameter or trees or shrubs with the root system still attached.

CONTRACTORS

Any tree service firm contracted by a village resident, is responsible for disposing of all brush, limbs and stumps.

LEAVES....

Annual curbside  leaf pick up will begin

October 23, 2017 thru November 17, 2017.

During that time leaves are collected daily, weather permitting, by neighborhood, according to a schedule, which is printed in the

Akron Bugle, Akron PennySaver and posted on our website www.erie.gov/akron
Leaves should be raked to the curb, but not into the street.

DO INCLUDE: Leaves only.

DO NOT INCLUDE: Anything else.

To dispose of leaves at times other than the annual scheduled leaf pick up, treat them as yard waste.



CHRISTMAS TREES....

Special pick ups for Christmas trees will be scheduled after the holidays and throughout January.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Hazardous material, such as oil based paint, insecticides, herbicides, solvents and unknown chemicals, **must not be placed in your trash.** The Village of Akron & the Town of Newstead periodically sponsor a Household Hazardous Waste drop off site for our community which are advertised in the **Akron Bugle, Akron Penny Saver and posted on our website** www.erie.gov/akron

Dates for drop off: Sat. April 22rd and Oct. 7th, 2017 9:00 am till Noon.

ELECTRONICS DROP OFF...

Will be held only on Saturday April 22rd & Saturday October 7th, 2017. A valid CRT Recycling Permit is required to recycle any CRT. Residents can recycle only two CRT's per year. The permit will be marked with each CRT recycled.

CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS....

If you are planning a remodeling project which will produce a substantial amount of debris, you will need to arrange to have a waste disposal company place a dumpster on your property. This will require a permit which may be obtained from the Village Office, 21 Main Street, for a fee of **\$50.00.**
