A SPECIAL MEETING of the Akron Village Board was held on this date at 7:00 P.M. Present: Mayor Ray M. Perkins, Trustees E. Peter Forrestel, Michael R. Middaugh, and William P. Kaufman, Village Attorney Daniel D. Shonn, Esq.

Mayor Ray M. Perkins called the special meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

No Parking – Brooklyn, Buell, Mechanic, Jackson – The Village of Akron Streets & Parks Committee discussed their recommendation for the Village's response to the letter dated August 11, 2005. The Village is in favor of a second stop sign on the left side of the roadway for south bound Cedar Street, at John Street. Also for the installation of larger intersection warning signs for northbound and southbound Route 93 in advance of Clarence Center Road and establishing a 45 MPH speed limit on Route 93 from Route 5 to the existing 35 MPH limit at Skyline Drive.

In regards to the changes in parking around Brooklyn, Buell, Mechanic and Jackson Streets, the Village would like to see the posting read "No Parking or Standing here to corner" 25' from these locations listed below.

- Northeast side of Buell Street from Brooklyn Street
- Southeast side of Buell Street to the driveway located at 6 Buell Street
- Northwest side of Buell Street from Jackson Street
- Southwest side of Buell Street from Jackson Street

The Mayor will draft a letter back to Mr. James Barnack from the State of New York Department of Transportation Region 5.

Northern Erie Sno-Seekers Snowmobile Club – The Village Board discussed possibly granting permission for the snowmobile club to use the Village of Akron bike path for snowmobile traffic through the Village this winter. Mayor Perkins read a memo from Village Attorney regarding his concerns for the proposed action. It was discussed to possibly allow a one year trial for the club to use the trail. The issue will be discussed again at the October 3, 2005 Village Board meeting.

They also discussed the possibility of creating all-season parking on Eckerson Avenue to access the bike path.

On a Motion of Michael Middaugh, seconded by William Kaufman, this meeting adjourned at 7:41 P.M.
