

- Supervisor Milligan informed Mary that he was recently made aware that the VFW and American Legion no longer are able to maintain the flagpole and flower beds in the cemetery, for which we allocate \$500. Would like Mary to follow up and see if this is a project the Boy Scouts would be willing to undertake.

* Parks Supt. Andy Sojka reported that football is starting with the first game being this Thursday.

* Hgwy. Supt. Gary Wagner:

- informed the board that he spoke with the fellow from Soil and Conservation to follow up on a previously raised question regarding funding received by Lancaster. There has been no funding released yet for this year, but he will keep us informed when funding becomes available.

- Sullivan Road project will be starting within the week and the guardrail will be placed on Pohl Road.

- Supervisor Milligan initiated discussion regarding attorney fees. Gary was informed and maintains that attorney fees should be taken out of the general fund if related to contract negotiations or collective bargaining. Supervisor Milligan disagreed and discussed his reasoning.

*Engineer Mike Metzger:

-touched on an idea Supervisor Milligan had regarding adding a small addition to concession stand in Robert O. Smith Park for the purpose of storage for the baseball league.

-brought the board up to date with information regarding Zoeller – Exchange water district. Most issues with involved agencies are good but reported on some information and concerns received late in the process from County DPW having to do with tree removal, some changes in culvert placement which could impact federal wetlands and the county's direction to place waterlines on far side of ditch, rather than road side. Mike is hopeful that these are issues which can be resolved with some explanation and will communicate this to DPW.

-a resolution from the Town Board is needed acknowledging and accepting the extra costs for the hydrants (the annual lease fee). Mike will provide Attorney Strong with the figures and she will prepare the resolution. Supervisor Milligan had questions regarding the tap-in fee. Assessor Sivecz asked when collection of special district charges is anticipated, as he would need the information by November.

* Councilman Witt reported that he has attempted to contact Mr. Zoladz on many occasions and has not heard back from him.

*Supervisor Milligan:

-reported on the status of the Gorniewicz proclamation ceremony re-naming the Alden Post Office.

-received a request from Assemblyman Kearns with regard to passing a resolution regarding stadium improvements. Board was not interested.

-reported that he, Councilman Witt and Mike Fleming from the Planning Board attended a meeting in Marilla regarding "equate".

-budget hearings will be held this week.
