

Mary Riddoch reported on the following:

- pre-construction meeting last Friday regarding Panza construction and NYS Parks & Recreation and Historic Preservation requirements.
- distributed letter just received from Alden School District regarding request for permission to use the blacktopped area of the park adjacent to the parking area behind the high school for presentation of simulated DWI car crash for prom students on May 4th, 2012.
- distributed letters from Alden Youth Baseball requesting permission to hold opening day parade on May 5th, 2012, to use concession stand throughout the 2012 baseball season, and requesting \$2,000.00 from the town to offset purchase of uniforms. Certificate of Insurance also received.

Bill Weber made mention of the article in last Thursday's Advertiser and took exception to the villages' remarks regarding finalizing the study on shared services with the town. He felt that the town was willing to negotiate but the village stood firm on their terms and resisted any concessions. Discussion held on what studies were completed and what needed further attention. Town informed village that we wanted to move forward with the study and filed for an extension. The article did not reflect that. Supervisor Milligan has a breakfast meeting with Mayor Manicki next Wednesday regarding this issue.

Supervisor Milligan complimented Andy Sojka for his assistance to a motorist in need, mentioned the NYS primary being held tomorrow and discussed the upcoming Recreation Dept. registration and the procedure for collecting, logging and depositing fees. Mary Nuwer will help out this year. Questioned whether there was any further progress on another traffic sign for North and Crittenden. Mary Riddoch is waiting for response from McCracken's office and will pursue.
