THE TONAWANDA CREEK AT RAPIDS

* UNTIL WEDNESDAY MORNING.

* AT 9 AM MONDAY THE STAGE WAS 13.3 FEET AND RISING.

* FLOOD STAGE IS 12.0 FEET.

* MINOR FLOODING IS OCCURRING AND MODERATE FLOODING IS
FORECAST.

* **FORECAST...THE RIVER WILL CONTINUE TO RISE AND CREST NEAR 15.7
FEET**

LATE TONIGHT.

* IMPACT...AT 16.0 FEET...MAJOR FLOOD...THERE IS WIDESPREAD
FLOODING

IN MOST OF NORTH CLARENCE AND NORTH AMHERST, ROYALTON, AND
NEWSTEAD

ALONG WITH MANY ROAD CLOSURES, INCLUDING MILLERSPORT
HIGHWAY AND

TONAWANDA CREEK ROAD. RANSOM OAKS AREA IN EAST AMHERST IS
INUNDATED

WITH BACKWATER INTO RANSOM, MUD, BEEMAN AND OTHER SMALL
CREEKS.

THERE IS SERIOUS FLOODING UPSTREAM INTO THE ALABAMA SWAMPS.
