Barricades have been removed and we are back in operation. There is a spot on Wolcott Road that is still wet and is marked with a high water sign and some cones. Delaware Road will remain closed through the weekend due to hard packed ice. There are no homes or businesses on that road so the effect of it remaining closed should be minimal to the residents.
