

Effective December 1, 2008 the Worker's Compensation Board will be changing the form required for a waiver for Worker's Compensation and Disability Insurances.

The current waiver form, WC/DB-100, will not be accepted after this date. Also, please note that ACCORD forms are not acceptable proof of New York State Worker's Comp. or Disability insurance.

The new waiver form, CE-200, will be required for EACH and EVERY new or renewed permit. Review the Worker's Comp website to determine if you qualify for the waiver. This form is used only if you do not have a current Workers Comp/Disability policy. Each CE-200 will have a certificate number assigned from the Worker's Comp. Bd. No permit application will be accepted without the proper insurance.

You can obtain these forms by logging on to the Workers Compensation Board's website, www.wcb.state.ny.us. The form can be completed on line and printed for submission to the Building Department.

There is no change in the use of the BP-1 form used for additions to existing dwellings.
