Goal: *To empower parents to use John Rosemond (www.rosemond.com) principles to raise children who are respectful, responsible and resourceful*

Method: *Lecture, interactive experiences, discussion and questions/answers
(Carri will develop an initial parenting plan for each family to address the specific issues they identify)*

Format: *Two 2-hour sessions (one per week) for a maximum of 30 people presented in an interactive and often humorous workshop to teach traditional parenting principles. The workshop will teach parents to bring loving leadership into their homes in ways that encourage their children to choose to follow their leadership.*

Parenting in the Teen Years covers the basic Rosemond principles, including parental leadership and authority, seasons of parenting, roles of parent and child, discipline, use of electronic entertainment, money/allowance, chores, and self-esteem vs confidence; with the primary focus on how to implement and successfully cope with the six “C’s” of the teenage years – Cash, Curfew, Consequences, Cohorts, Conflict and Cars.
