BUFFALO, NY (WBFO) - Independent auditors won't finish reviewing Erie County's 2010 financials until June, but County Comptroller Mark Poloncarz is warning that a surplus identified by County Executive Chris Collins is tenuous at best.

Poloncarz points out that a nearly \$24 million surplus reported by Collins is largely comprised of one-time stimulus revenues.
