Mechanics of 'bridge' loan subject of Monday meeting

The Erie County Legislature will break from its summer recess for a special session at 1:30 p. m. Monday on the fourth floor of Old County Hall.

Lawmakers are expected to determine whether to authorize the state-appointed control board to arrange the county's next bridge loan, of about \$90 million, or ask County Comptroller Mark C. Poloncarz to close the deal based on the offers he has received from underwriters.

Lawmakers are also being asked to take the final procedural vote required to renew the county sales tax rate at 8.75 percent, and to authorize County Executive Chris Collins to rearrange health care jobs in the county Holding Center.
