Description:

The NYS Office of Emergency Management (NYSOEM), in conjunction with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC), Dam Safety Section (DSS), invites you to participate in a *Dam Safety Workshop for Owners, Operators, and Emergency Management Officials*.

The workshop is designed to provide practical information and guidance regarding new state regulatory and preparedness mandates aimed at Moderate (Class B) and High-Hazard (Class C) dam owners and operators, including the preparation and submission of a facility-specific Emergency Action Plan (EAP).

In addition, the workshop will include information and guidance to support the development of a hazard-specific (Dam Failure Emergency) annex to a local Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (CEMP). This guidance will be provided for local emergency management officials and response agencies that are primarily responsible to protect lives, property and the environment from the consequences of a dam failure.

Further, an overview regarding the necessary coordination and relationship of these distinct planning efforts and team members will be presented along with the opportunity for NYS dam owners and operators to network with local and State emergency preparedness professionals and discuss topics of importance to all parties.

Cost: There is no fee for the course. *Food and Transportation* costs are the responsibility of the participant.
