Do you want to become more prepared, so you can help your family and even your community during a disaster? Now is the time!

Several local groups have come together to host basic Community Emergency Response Training (CERT). The West Seneca Office of Disaster Preparedness, the Town of Elma Office of Emergency Management, and EMPact America will sponsor this training, which is free and open to all residents in WNY (14 Years and up).

The same course will be offered in two different day/time slots to accommodate different schedules. One will be offered

Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and the other will be offered on Saturdays.

Weekday Evening Classes (Tuesday and Thursday) – will run from Tuesday, January 24, 2012 through Thursday February 9, 2012, from 7 PM to 9 PM (class dates: 1/24, 1/26, 1/31, 2/02, 2/07 & 2/09 - a total of six 2-hour sessions)

Saturday Classes – will be held from Saturday, February 18, 2012 through Saturday March 3, 2012, from 9 AM – 1:30 PM (class dates: 2/18, 2/25 & 3/3 - a total of three 4.5-hour sessions, including a ½ hr. break)

Classes will be held in the Jamison Office Park, Main Cafeteria, 611 Jamison Road, Elma, NY (Jamison exit off the 400).
