Description:

The (L-954) All-Hazards Safety Officer Course is one of the new ICS Position Specific Courses developed by the US Fire Administration in cooperation with the National Wildfire Coordinating Group under the All Hazards IMT Program. Upon completion of this course the trainee will be provided the opportunity to demonstrate through a major exercise simulation, the knowledge and skills necessary to perform the duties and responsibilities of a Safety Officer or Assistant in the Incident Command System (ICS).

Unit 7 – Site Safety and Control Plan, ICS Form 208 HM
Unit 8 – Incident Safety Plan
Unit 9 – Coordination with Logistics Section
Unit 10 – Coordination with Operations Section
Unit 11 & 12 – Special Situations; Demobilization & Close-out

Prerequisite: The prerequisite to enroll in this course is completion of the ICS Intermediate (I-300) course “ICS for Expanding Incidents”
