
Dear Mr. Kerl:

Please consider this the formal issuing of **Work Order No. 20** effective April 20, 2016, for the Erie County Sewer Districts No. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 Cured-in-Place Pipe Lining Term Agreement, Contract 70. This Work Order covers work to be complete in the Erie County Sewer District No. 1 under the 2016 Northern Region budget allocation.

Per our discussions and approval by United Survey Inc., this Work Order is being issued for a quantity of work less than the \$100,000 minimum established in our Agreement. This Work Order is for the completion of the spot repair on the 10-inch diameter asbestos concrete pipe (ACP) sewerline in the lawn of 185 Seneca Creek Road with intent of installing a cured-in-place liner in a subsequent Work Order. It is understood that the challenging location of the spot repair, the hazardous pipe material, and special disposal requirements of asbestos are exceptions to the otherwise applicable Bid Item 5E (Sewer Spot Repair 14' or deeper) established in our Term Agreement. This repair therefore qualifies for additional compensation. The \$20,512.80 total cost of this repair established in your proposal dated April 18, 2016 (attached) is acceptable. The base \$6,375.00 cost established under Bid Item 5E will be paid as such, with the balance of \$14,137.80 paid under Bid Item 6 (Contingent Items). This will be considered full compensation for this repair.

PROPOSAL – 10" Transite Pipe at 185 Seneca Creek Road

Replacement of the 10" transite pipe including mobilization, excavation, removal and disposal of the 10" transite (asbestos) pipe, abatement of the transite pipe by licensed company, 10" SDR-35 pipe 13LF, 10" fernco couplings 2 each, pipe bedding stone, select backfill as needed with compaction thereof, asphalt driveway pavement replacement adjacent to excavation (as needed), lawn restoration for lawn disturbed by Milherst, demobilization, New York State Prevailing Wage Rates and disposal of surplus excavated material.

Pricing excludes by-pass pumping (by Erie County), restoration of any type due to by-pass pumping, clearing & grubbing, tree replacement, pipe lining and service laterals.
