

We last met on 5/24/16, 10am, at the Town of Tonawanda Police Headquarters. The following was discussed:

- ✓ Volunteer Angel training. (You and I discussed this issue on Tuesday, 5/31/16)
- ✓ The hours of operation of REAP will be 7am-2pm, Monday thru Friday. (This may be different from the operational hours of the proposed Terrace House Annex plan)
- ✓ Still trying to determine if Liberty cab and MASH transport will be involved in moving REAP eligible individuals from Terrane House to rehab facilities.
- ✓ Lt Rinaldo of Buffalo PD advised that 44 individuals have signed up to be Angels.
- ✓ Nearly all of the 44 have been vetted.
- ✓ Lt Rinaldo will break down Angel list by zip code.
- ✓ Decided that August 1<sup>st</sup>, will be the roll out date for the REAP program.
- ✓ Lt Rinaldo will arrange to have Angels issued photo identification cards, identifying them as being associated with the REAP program.
- ✓ Was advised by Robin Clouden that there is a construction project going on at the Terrace House Annex to make it suitable for use by REAP. Clouden did not have an end date for the construction project.
- ✓ Decided that during the Angel training program, the Angels would be asked about availability.
- ✓ The work group decided that having a number of Angels available on a “day of the week” basis would probably be the best way utilize them.
- ✓ I advised the group that the Crisis Services funding was approved by the county legislature.
- ✓ Showed the work group the Crisis Services chart that was put together by Jessica Pierro. Many suggestions were made to update/improve the chart.
- ✓ Distributed a REAP chart that was put together by Mary St Mary. This chart appears to capture correctly what would occur when someone enters a police station seeking help.
- ✓ Next meeting scheduled for Tuesday, 6/28/16, 10 am at the Town of Tonawanda Police Department.
