### **Health Advisory #109 - Zemco Industry - Frankfurter Recall - November 10, 2004**

Zemco Industry of Buffalo, NY is recalling about 50,000 pounds of frankfurters because of possible undercooking. The Agriculture Department said it has not received any reports of illnesses caused by the meat, which was recalled after the company received a consumer complaint. The hot dogs were sold in one- to five-pound packages on Oct 5 and 6 and distributed to stores in Connecticut, Massachusetts, Maine, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York and Vermont. Each package bears the code EST. 5222. The recalled brand names have sell-by-dates of Dec 14 or 15 and include; Jordan's Natural Casing, Deutschmacher, Essem Frankfurters, Kirschner Natural Casing, Stop & Shop Premium, Ferraro's Food Center, and Hofmann.
