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UPDATE: ERIE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH ON MULTISTATE FUNGAL MENINGITIS OUTBREAK

ERIE COUNTY, NY— The Erie County Department of Health ("ECDOH") is issuing this update in response to the nationwide outbreak of fungal meningitis among patients who received potentially contaminated epidural steroid injections. None of the contaminated product was shipped to Erie County, and there have been no confirmed or suspected cases of fungal meningitis in Erie County. Additionally, there are no confirmed or suspected cases of fungal meningitis in New York State to date.
