



CFR/EMT Supplement Training

There have been a number of questions regarding the CFR/EMT National Standards Supplement training. The explanation below is intended to provide clarification for first responders and agencies.

In 2012, the NYS Bureau of EMS adopted the National EMS curriculum. Since that date, the focus of training programs has been to develop and deliver courses that comply with the National Education Standards. The local programs continue to be adapted to ensure all the course materials have been delivered. Additionally, NYS Bureau of EMS issued a statement that all EMT's, AEMT's, Critical Care Technicians and Paramedics who were not trained under the National Standards will be required to obtain the supplemental training by June 30, 2014. The following criteria should be used as a guide to identify providers in your agency who may need the supplemental training:

1. Providers who attended an original certification program AND who took the NYS written exam PRIOR to December 2012 should plan to attend the supplemental training.
2. Providers who took a recert course (NOT the CME recert) AND who took the NYS written exam PRIOR to December 2012 should plan to attend the supplemental training.
3. Providers in the CME Recertification Program can attend this supplemental training program to ensure compliance with the June 30th deadline.
4. Any questions concerning your agency's CME program and its compliance with the June 30th deadline should be directed to the overseeing CIC for your CME program.
5. As a rule of thumb, providers should plan to attend this training if there is any question or doubt as to whether the training will be complete by June 30th.

The supplemental training requirement will be satisfied when providers attend an "A Module" and a "B Module" from the list below:
