Please note: We do not perform titers

Please bring:

- **Cash (exact change) or check for the visit fee of \$17.85 plus the cost of the vaccine (see chart below). These charges are due at the time of your visit.**
- All immunization records
- Documentation from school showing requirement that student needs to be immunized (when applicable)
- Parent or legal guardian for those under age 18
