A LOCAL LAW amending Local Law No. 1 - 1960, constituting the Erie County Administrative Code, by amending § 2.03 thereof to provide that the form and procedure for the adoption of local laws shall be as provided in the New York State Municipal Home Rule Law instead of as in Article 6 of the County Law which latter article has been repealed.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ERIE COUNTY LEGISLATURE, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Purpose. Erie County Administrative Code § 2.03 presently provides that the form and procedure for the adoption of a local law shall be as provided in Article 6 of the County Law. Article 6 of the County Law was repealed by the Municipal Home Rule Law, effective January 1, 1964, and some of the provisions previously set forth in Article 6 of the County Law as they pertain to the adoption of a local law have been changed, so instant local law is designed to bring the local law adoption procedure in Erie County into conformity with the Municipal Home Rule Law.

Section 2. § 2.03 of Local Law No. 1 - 1960, constituting the Erie County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 2.03. Local laws; form and procedure. Except as provided in the county charter or this code, the form and procedure for the adoption of a local law, including referendum, mandatory or permissive, shall be as provided in (Article 6 of the County Law) the New York State Municipal Home Rule Law.

Section 3. Effective date. This local law shall be effective immediately.
