A LOCAL LAW amending Local Law No. 1 - 1959, as amended, constituting the Erie County Charter, by amending Section 401 thereof by adding qualifications for the commissioner of finance.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ERIE COUNTY LEGISLATURE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 401 of Local Law No. 1 - 1959, as amended, constituting the Erie County Charter, is amended to read as follows:

§ 401. Department of finance; commissioner; board of equalization and elective office of treasurer abolished. There shall be a department of finance headed by a commissioner, who shall be appointed by the county executive subject to confirmation by the county legislature. The commissioner shall possess at least five years of practical experience in public accounting and be a licensed public accountant by the State of New York and/or shall have five years of administrative experience in the area of finance or shall possess a combination of said requirements. The Erie county equalization board act, being chapter three hundred four of the laws of nineteen hundred nineteen as amended, is hereby repealed, and the elective office of county treasurer shall be abolished, as of January first, nineteen hundred sixty-one.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
