A LOCAL LAW amending Section 2., subsection a., iii.; and Section 2., subsection a., 3., of Erie County Local Law No. 7 - 1973, known as the Code of Ethics for the County of Erie.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ERIE COUNTY LEGISLATURE, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2., subsection a., iii., of Erie County Local Law No. 7 - 1973, is amended to read as follows:

iii. is authorized in the usual course of his duties to exercise a substantial degree of discretion in financial or regulatory transactions with private entities shall, within 30 days after taking office and within 30 days after any change in the status of the matters hereinafter enumerated, file with [the County Clerk] the head of his department or administrative unit and with the County Clerk a statement in writing, identifying:

Section 2. Section 2., subsection a., 3., of Erie County Local Law No. 7 - 1973, is amended to read as follows:

3. Self-employment or employment by or membership in or on the board of directors of any corporation, partnership, association, person or other entity from which he derives gross income in excess of \$500.00 per year.

Any such county officer or employee who does not have any such interests shall so file a statement to that effect. Such statements of disclosure shall be matters of public record and shall be indexed, maintained on file in an

appropriate manner by the County Clerk.

It shall be the responsibility of the head of every county department or administrative unit:

(a) prior to January 31 of each year to determine and compile a list of the persons in his department or agency who in his judgment are within the scope of this provision and to notify them in writing of this requirement [.] ; and

(b) to review all statements of disclosure filed with him and to take such action as may be required in relation to any interest, subject to any other provision of this Code, any provision of Article 18 of the General Municipal Law, or any other applicable provision or principle of law.

Section 3. Effective date. This local law shall take effect immediately.
