A LOCAL LAW authorizing the County Executive with approval of the County Legislature to lease to St. Augustine's Center, Inc. the facility formerly known as the Buffalo Family Care Center, comprising approximately 12,095+- square feet of renovated space located in Old School 84 on the grounds of the Edward J. Meyer Memorial Hospital, in the City of Buffalo, and to lease any additional unrenovated space in Old School 84, without advertising or competitive bidding.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ERIE COUNTY LEGISLATURE

AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section two hundred fifteen of the County Law or any special act or local law, the County Executive is hereby authorized and empowered, with approval of the County Legislature, to lease to St. Augustine's Center, Inc., upon such terms and conditions as the County Executive shall in his discretion determine, without advertising or competitive bidding or public sale, approximately 12,095 +- square feet of renovated space located in Old School 84, being the former facilities of the Buffalo

Family Care Center, on the grounds of the Erie County Medical Center, formerly known as the Edward J. Meyer Memorial Hospital, in the City of Buffalo, plus such additional unrenovated space in said Old School 84 as the County Executive shall in his discretion determine.

The County Executive is hereby authorized and empowered to enter into such contracts which he may in his discretion determine to be necessary to effectuate the terms of the said lease to St. Augustine's Center, Inc.

Section Two Hundred Fifteen of the County Law shall have no application to the said lease.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately subject to the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.
