**WHEREAS**, Annette Adamczak's efforts have called attention to the need for AED units throughout the community and through her leadership, three units are now in service at Akron area sports fields; and

**WHEREAS**, Annette Adamczak has recognized the importance of administering timely cardiac resuscitation in an emergency and has partnered with others to provide CPR training to more than 2,000 high school students; and

**WHEREAS**, Annette Adamczak continues to give back to her community as a long-time volunteer for the Women and Children's Hospital Variety Kids Telethon and the Erie County 4-H program; and

**WHEREAS**, She was just recently honored as the 2012 Citizen of the Year by the Akron Chamber of Commerce acknowledging her tireless efforts in the community ; and
