**I HEREBY CERTIFY**, that at a regular session of the Legislature of Erie County, held in the County Hall, in the City of Buffalo, on the 12th day of July 2012, A.D. a resolution was adopted, of which the following is a true copy:

**WHEREAS**, Jacob Kaminski is a former resident of the Town of Elma N.Y., and;

**WHEREAS**, Jacob Kaminski's passion for the sport of archery has hometown roots when at the age of 5 he won a bow at a Jamison Road Fire Company event, and;

**WHEREAS**, Jacob Kaminski entered State and Regional Tournaments beginning his competitive career in 1997 at the age of 9, winning the New York State Indoor Championships that same year, and;

**WHEREAS**, Jacob Kaminski at the age of 18 moved to the U.S. Olympic Training Center in Chula Vista, California, and;

**WHEREAS**, Jacob Kaminski career holds a long list of accomplishments that includes finishing sixth in the 2000 Outdoor National Championships, earning a gold and silver with his U.S. teammates on the 2010 World Cup circuit, taking fourth and fifth place individual finishes at the 2011 World Cup events, as well as three more team gold medals, and earning a silver medal at the World Archery Indoor Championships in 2012, and;

**WHEREAS**, Jacob Kaminski has been named to the U.S. Olympic Archery Squad for the 2012 Summer Games in London, and;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that this legislative body paused in its deliberations to acknowledge the Town of Elma N.Y. declaring July 6, 2012 as "**Jacob Kaminski Day**" in honor of his accomplishments that earned him a spot in the 2012 Olympic Games.
