WHEREAS, *Michael P. Kramer is a resident of the City of Tonawanda, husband of Jennifer and proud father of Brooke, Briann, Madison and Mackenzie; and*

WHEREAS, *Michael P. Kramer graduated from Tonawanda High School in 1984, and attended Marietta College where he graduated in 1988 with a Bachelors Degree in Business Management; and*

WHEREAS, *Michael P. Kramer played Division-III baseball while at Marietta College where he was a four-year letterman; earned three all conference titles; two all Mid East Region titles; was All American Honorable Mention in 1985; and helped the school earn the 1986 NCAA Division III National Championship; and*

WHEREAS, *Michael P. Kramer began playing baseball as a pitcher in the Tonawanda News league at the age of 16 and played until his retirement in 2006; and*

WHEREAS, *Michael P. Kramer also played in the Suburban, Erie-Niagara and MUNY AAA leagues, pitching for 10 wins which is the most wins by a player in the Western New York leagues and earning admiration from teammates and opponents alike; and*
