I HEREBY CERTIFY, That at a regular session of the Legislature of Erie County, held in the County Hall, in the City of Buffalo, on the 27th day of September, 2012, A.D., a resolution was adopted, of which the following is a true copy:

WHEREAS, Lawrence P. Titzler is a resident of the Town of Tonawanda; and

WHEREAS, Lawrence P. Titzler has been married for 62 years to the former Irene Lebieda, is the father of Paul and Susan, grandfather of four and great-grandfather of one; and

WHEREAS, Lawrence P. Titzler attended Chown Business School in downtown Buffalo hoping to become a certified public accountant; and

WHEREAS, Lawrence P. Titzler spent 1943 studying in the Army's engineering program at Princeton University; and

WHEREAS, Lawrence P. Titzler landed with the 78th Infantry "Lightning" Division, where he became a medic with B Company, 303rd Medical Battalion, arriving in Europe in October of 1944; and

WHEREAS, Lawrence P. Titzler, in 1944, was a front line medic at the Battle of the Bulge, serving in the German town of Lammersdorf, where he received and processed information concerning significant challenges of planned troop movements and what medics could expect; and

WHEREAS, Lawrence P. Titzler attended the University of Buffalo after his honorable discharge from the service, graduating with a degree in Business Administration in 1948, and went on to become a business teacher and assistant principal Tonawanda High School, retiring in 1989.
