

**A RESOLUTION TO BE SUBMITTED
BY LEGISLATOR McCRACKEN**

RE: Public Notice Concerning Marilla Agricultural District #5 Eight-Year Review

WHEREAS, the Erie County Legislature has received notification for the eight-year review requirement of the Marilla Agricultural District #5, which was created on December 4, 1973 pursuant to New York State Agriculture and Markets Law ("Agriculture and Markets Law") Section 303; and

WHEREAS, Marilla Agricultural District #5 has been recertified every eight years thereafter pursuant to Agriculture and Markets Law Section 303-a(1); and

WHEREAS, a copy of this Agricultural District map is on file in the County Clerk's office, and the Marilla Town Hall.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Legislature be directed to publish a public notice in a newspaper having general circulation within the area of the above agricultural district, that notice be posted in at least five conspicuous places within the district, and that notice also be sent to the affected municipalities, being the town of Marilla; and be it further

RESOLVED, that after this 30-day period, the Legislature hereby directs the Clerk to refer the Marilla Agricultural District to the Erie County Department of Environment and Planning and the Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board for a report and recommendations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Erie County Department of Environment and Planning and the Town of Marilla Supervisor and Town Clerk.
