

A RESOLUTION TO BE SUBMITTED BY
LEGISLATOR LORIGO

RE: Aid for the West Seneca Flood Victims

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Erie County Legislature to help secure assistance to victims of catastrophic damage; and

WHEREAS, due to ice and floodwaters of Buffalo Creek numerous West Seneca residents were subjected to emergency evacuation and damage to their homes, neighborhoods, and personal property; and

WHEREAS, the State of New York routinely grants emergency disaster relief funds to victims of natural disasters including flooding in the summer of 2013 as well as to those suffering flood damage due to hurricane related weather.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Erie County Legislature requests State aid in assisting the members of our community in their cleanup effort due to the recent flooding; and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be sent to Governor Andrew Cuomo's Office, the Western New York Delegation of the State Legislature, Assembly Speaker Sheldon Silver, Majority Leader Joseph Morelle, Minority Leader Brian M. Kolb, the Erie County Executive and the NYS Disaster Relief Program and all others deemed necessary and proper.
