MEMORANDUM

SUMMARY

The Department of Environment and Planning is requesting authorization for the movement of funds between the capital project accounts, capital reserve, and operating accounts of various Erie County Sewer Districts (ECSDs) to close out completed capital projects and to facilitate final accounting of monies used for the completed projects.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There will be no fiscal implications to the County's general fund. Residual equity transfers will be processed to move the funds to/from the ECSD capital reserve projects to sewer district capital and/or operating accounts.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

Various capital project accounts have positive or negative balances that need to be cleared to close out the capital project fund account.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Capital projects were approved and funds were allocated from bond authorizations, capital reserve funds, or operating funds. These projects have now been completed. Some of these projects have remaining cash balances that need to be applied to the related debt service or the original source of funds. Additionally some of these projects have balances that need to be funded with capital reserves to allow for final close out.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION

The capital project accounts will not be properly funded with all monies applied to project contracts, leaving the capital project account with a zero balance. These projects will not be closed out and will remain open pending the final accounting of funds.

STEPS TO FOLLOW APPROVAL

The required transfers of funds will be made to clear balances on completed capital accounts. The accounts will then be closed out.

COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE REVIEW

The proposed legislation has been reviewed by the Comptroller's Office and is related to capital accounts for which there are sufficient funds available for the actions proposed.

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Legislature be directed to send one (1) certified copy each of this Resolution to the County Executive, the Erie County Comptroller, and the Director of Budget and Management; and two (2) certified copies be sent to Joseph L. Fiegl, P.E. Department of Environment and Planning, Division of Sewerage Management.
