

LOCAL LAW No. 2 - 1954

A local law in relation to the salaries of certain officials appointed for a definite term in the county of Erie.

Be it enacted by the board of supervisors of the county of Erie, as follows:

Section 1. The salary of the commissioner of buildings, upon appointment, shall be eight thousand six hundred ten dollars per year, the same to be increased at the rate of six hundred twenty dollars per year, until the maximum salary of eleven thousand ninety dollars is attained.

The salaries of the commissioners of elections, upon appointment, shall be seven thousand six hundred fifty dollars per year, the same to be increased at the rate of five hundred fifty* dollars per year, until the maximum salary of nine thousand eight hundred fifty dollars is attained.

The salaries of the commissioners of equalization, upon appointment, shall be six thousand eight hundred twenty dollars per year, the same to be increased at the rate of four hundred eighty-five dollars per year, until the maximum salary of eight thousand seven hundred sixty dollars is attained.

The salary of the purchasing agent, upon appointment, shall be eight thousand six hundred ten dollars per year, the same to be increased at the rate of six hundred twenty dollars per year, until the maximum salary of eleven thousand ninety dollars is attained.

§ 2. The present incumbents in the offices set forth in section one herein, shall immediately receive the maximum salaries herein provided.

§ 3. This local law shall take effect immediately.
