

LOCAL LAW No. 2 - 1956

A local law empowering the chairman of the Erie county board of supervisors to authorize county officers and county employees to attend conferences or conventions, pursuant to the provisions of section seventy-seven-b of the General Municipal Law.

*Be it enacted by the board of supervisors of the county of Erie as follows:*

Section 1. The chairman of the Erie county board of supervisors is hereby empowered to authorize county officers and county employees to attend official or unofficial conferences or conventions of municipal officers or employees conducted for the betterment of municipal government, pursuant to the provisions of section seventy-seven-b of the General Municipal Law. Nothing herein shall be deemed to empower the chairman of the Erie county board of supervisors to authorize county officers and county employees to attend any schools conducted for the betterment of municipal government.

§ 2. When so authorized, such officer or employee shall be reimbursed by the county of Erie for his actual and necessary expenses of travel, meals and lodging.

§ 3. This local law shall take effect immediately.
