

COUNTY OF ERIE

LOCAL LAW No. 1 1962

A local law to authorize the comptroller of the county of Erie to deduct from the wage or salary of any officer or employee the amount of any pledge to the United Fund of Buffalo and Erie county.

Became a law September 24, 1962 with the approval of the Legislative Body, no petition protesting. Passed by the local legislative body of the county of Erie. Filed in the office of the secretary of state September 28, 1962.

*Be it enacted by the board of supervisors of the county of Erie as follows:*

Section 1. The comptroller of the county of Erie is hereby authorized to deduct from the wage or salary of any officer or employee of said county the amount of any pledge made to the United Fund of Buffalo and Erie county as such officer or employee may specify in a writing filed with the said comptroller and transmit to the said United Fund of Buffalo and Erie county the sum so deducted. Any such written authorization may be withdrawn by such officer or employee at any time upon filing written notice of such withdrawal with the county comptroller.

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
