

LOCAL LAW No. 2 - 1965

A local law to amend the Erie county administrative code in relation to the powers and duties of the deputy commissioner of public works over refuse disposal.

Became a law with the approval of the acting county executive, April 29, 1965. Passed by the local legislative body of the county of Erie. Filed in the office of the secretary of state May 6, 1965.

Be it enacted by the board of supervisors of the county of Erie as follows:

Section 1. Section 10.05, subdivision (b) of article ten of the Erie county administrative code is hereby amended to read as follows:

b. The deputy commissioner for drainage, sanitation, and refuse disposal shall (1) assemble data relating to the sewage collection, conveyance, treatment and disposal problems of the county and of its political subdivisions and the elimination or alleviation of such problems;

(2) Furnish technical advice, information and recommendations to assist the Erie county sewer agency, the Erie county drainage agency and the Erie county refuse disposal agency in the performance of their duties;

(3) Act as director of the Erie county sewer agency;

(4) Analyze and evaluate information for the establishment, development, coordination and utilization of existing sewer facilities to service other municipalities in the county;

(5) Prepare maps, plans and cost estimates on sewer facilities, compile economic data in support thereof and coordinate survey results in connection with a master sewer plan;

(6) Prepare reports on studies and works* with local municipalities in the formation of county sewer districts and in connection therewith co-operate with local, state and federal agencies on program hearings and surveys;

(7) Prepare or supervise the preparation of plans and specifications for construction work undertaken by any county sewer district and supervise and inspect the work;

(8) Make studies, conduct investigations and assemble data for the purpose of drainage and to protect property and public health within the county from floods and high waters and submit the results of such studies and investigations with his recommendations to the commissioner of public works or to any village, town or city in the county requesting the same;

(9) Make studies, conduct investigations and assemble data for the purpose of the collection and disposition of garbage, ashes, rubbish and other waste matter within the county and submit the results of such studies and investigations with his recommendations to the commissioner of public works or to any village, town or city in the county requesting the same.

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
