

COUNTY OF ERIE

LOCAL LAW No. 1 - 1968

A local law to assume the liability for negligence of the county clerk and his employees committed in the discharge of their duties within the scope of their employment.

Became a law with the approval of the county executive, October 17, 1968. Passed by the local legislative body of the county of Erie. Filed in the office of the secretary of state October 22, 1968.

*Be it enacted by the legislature of the county of Erie as follows:*

Section 1. The county of Erie assumes the liability to save harmless and protect its county clerk and employees of the county clerk's office from financial loss arising out of any claim, demand, suit or judgment by reason of alleged negligence of said county clerk or employees, provided such act was committed in the discharge of their duties and within the scope of their employment.

§ 2. The county may purchase and maintain appropriate insurance with any insurance company authorized to do business in the state of New York for coverage against such liability.

§ 3. This local law shall take effect on the twentieth day after its final adoption.
