

LOCAL LAW No. 10 - 1971

A local law in relation to the salaries of the county court judges, the family court judges and the surrogate in the county of Erie.

Became a law with the approval of the county executive, December 30, 1971. Passed by the local legislative body of the county of Erie. Filed in the office of the secretary of state January 3, 1972.

*Be it enacted by the legislature of the county of Erie as follows:*

Section 1. The salaries of the county court judges, the family court judges and the surrogate in the county of Erie shall be and hereby are fixed in the sum of thirty-six thousand dollars.

§ 2. This local law shall supersede local law number one — nineteen hundred sixty-nine.

§ 3. This local law shall take effect immediately.
