

LOCAL LAW No. 13 - 1972

A local law to amend the Erie county charter, in relation to establishing a division of data processing.

Became a law with the approval of the county executive, November 2, 1972. Passed by the local legislative body of the county of Erie. Filed in the office of the secretary of state November 8, 1972.

*Be it enacted by the legislature of the county of Erie as follows:*

Section 1. The Erie county charter, being local law number one—nineteen hundred fifty-nine, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be known as section three hundred ten of article III to read as follows:

§ 310. Division of data processing. a. There shall be in the office of the county executive a division of data processing, headed by the director of data processing. He shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the county executive. The director of data processing shall: (1) have charge and supervision of planning, development, coordination and operation of all computers and related electronic equipment in the data processing division and of the informational output processed thereby and shall coordinate all county-owned or county-operated computers and related electronic equipment; (2) have charge and supervision of storage and processing of data as may be required by departments and agencies participating in its services; (3) supply such data as needed and requested by the participating departments and agencies; (4) coordinate all data handling procedures employed by the county; (5) advise and assist the county executive and legislature in matters related to the installation and application of new data processing programs; and (6) perform such other related duties as the county executive may prescribe.

b. Subject to the approval of the county legislature, the county executive may enter into a contract with the federal government, state government and any municipal corporation to provide data processing services to such corporation.

§ 2. Effective date. This local law shall be effective immediately.
