

A local law amending local law number one—nineteen hundred sixty, as amended, constituting the Erie county administrative code, by repealing article nine thereof, thereby eliminating the department of planning and the planning advisory board; by adding to article three a new section to be known as 3.08A, establishing a division of planning and a county development coordination board; and by deleting from section 18.03 the words "planning commissioner" and the words "planning advisory board" and inserting respectively in the place thereof the words "planning director" and the words "development coordination board".

Became a law with the approval of the county executive, January 10, 1973. Passed by the local legislative body of the county of Erie. Filed in the office of the secretary of state January 19, 1973.

Be it enacted by the legislature of the county of Erie as follows:

Section 1. Elimination of the department of planning and of the planning advisory board. Local law number one—nineteen hundred sixty, as amended, constituting the Erie county administrative code, is hereby amended by repealing article nine thereof, thereby eliminating the department of planning and the planning advisory board.

§ 2. Establishment of division of planning and of a county development coordination board. Local law number one—nineteen hundred sixty, as amended, constituting the Erie county administrative code, is hereby amended by adding to article three a new section to be known as 3.08A, to read as follows:

§ 3.08.A Division of planning; county development coordination board. a. The planning director shall be the head of the division of planning and shall be a person qualified by professional training and experience in the field of regional, county, or municipal planning. The planning director shall have and exercise all the powers of a county planning board heretofore or hereafter lawfully granted or imposed by the county charter, by this code, by local law, ordinance, or resolution of the county legislature, by the county executive, or by any applicable provisions of any act of the legislature not inconsistent with the county charter or this code.

b. There shall be a county development coordination board consisting of nine members who shall be as follows: the commissioner of health; the commissioner of public works; the chairman of the environmental management council, or his designee; a member of the county legislature selected by the chairman of the legislature as being chairman of the appropriate committee of the legislature dealing with matters within the jurisdiction of the county development coordination board; five persons designated by the county executive subject to confirmation by the county legislature and which persons are not county officials or employees. The county executive shall designate one of the nine members to serve as chairman of the board during the pleasure of

the county executive. The five members of the board designated by the county executive shall serve for a term of two years, except that of those first designated, three shall serve for a term expiring December thirty-first, nineteen hundred seventy-three. Meetings of the board shall be held at the call of the chairman or the director of planning on three days' written notice mailed to the last known address of such board members. The members of the board shall receive no salary or compensation for their services as members of such board, but shall, within the appropriations provided therefor, be entitled to actual disbursements and expenses in performing the duties of their office. The county development coordination board shall be advisory to the director of planning in matters related to comprehensive regional, county, and municipal planning.

§ 3. Amendment of section 18.03 of the Erie county administrative code. Section 18.03 of the Erie county administrative code is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the words "planning commissioner" and the words "planning advisory board" and inserting respectively in the place thereof the words "planning director" and the words "development coordination board".

§ 4. Effective date. This local law shall become effective on January first, nineteen hundred seventy-three.
