

LOCAL LAW No. 8 - 1973

A local law authorizing the county executive, with approval of the county legislature, to lease to The Research Foundation of the State University of New York approximately 12,095 ± square feet of renovated space located in old school 84 at the Edward J. Meyer Memorial Hospital in the city of Buffalo, without advertising or competitive bidding.

Became a law June 11, 1973 with the approval of the county executive, no petition protesting. Passed by the local legislative body of the county of Erie. Filed in the office of the secretary of state June 13, 1973.

*Be it enacted by the legislature of the county of Erie as follows:*

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section two hundred fifteen of the County Law or any special act or local law, the county executive is hereby authorized and empowered, with approval of the county legislature, to lease to The Research Foundation of the State University of New York, upon such terms and conditions as to duration, renewals, extensions, assignment, rentals, rehabilitation, maintenance and repair, and other matters as the county executive shall in his discretion determine, without advertising or competitive bidding or public sale, approximately 12,095 ± square feet of renovated space located in old school 84 at the Edward J. Meyer Memorial Hospital in the city of Buffalo. Section two hundred fifteen of the County Law shall have no application to the said lease.

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately, subject to the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the state of New York.
