A LOCAL LAW amending Local Law No. 1 - 1959, as amended, constituting the Erie County Charter, by amending Section 310 a. thereof by adding qualifications for the director of the division of data processing.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ERIE COUNTY LEGISLATURE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 310 a. of Local Law No. 1 - 1959, as amended, constituting the Erie County Charter, is amended to read as follows:

§ 310. Division of data processing.

There shall be in the office of the county executive a division of data processing, headed by the director of data processing. He shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the county executive. The director of data processing shall be a person qualified by professional training and practical or administrative experience in the area of data processing. The director of data processing shall: (1) have charge and supervision of planning, development, coordination and operation of all computers and related electronic equipment in the data processing division and of the informational output processed thereby and shall coordinate all county-owned or county-operated computers and related electronic equipment; (2) have charge and supervision of storage and processing of data as may be required by departments and agencies participating in its services; (3) supply such data as naeded and requested by the participating departments and agencies; (4) coordinate all data handling procedures employed by the county; (5) advise and assist the county executive and legislature in matters related to the installation and application of new data processing programs; and (6) perform such other related duties as the county executive may prescribe.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
