A LOCAL LAW amending Erie County Local Law No. 1 - 1959, as amended, constituting the Erie County Charter, by amending Article XX, Section 2002 thereof, to provide that any local law which would change the term of office for county legislators shall be subject to mandatory referendum.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ERIE COUNTY LEGISLATURE, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Article XX, Section 2002, of Erie County Local Law No. 1 - 1959, as amended, constituting the Erie County Charter, is hereby amended to read as follows:


Section 2002. Amendment of charter.


This charter may be amended in the manner provided by law. Any local law which would create or abolish an elective county office, change an elective office to appointive or an appointive office to elective, or change the powers of an elective county officer, or change the term of office for county legislators shall be subject to mandatory referendum. No local law which would abolish or change an administrative unit prescribed in this charter or the power of an appointive county officer in the executive branch may be passed before January first, nineteen hundred sixty-one.

Section 2. Effective date. This local law shall
be effective immediately.
