A LOCAL LAW to amend Local Law No. 1-1959, constituting the Erie County Charter, as amended, in relation to establishing a Charter Revision Commission by repealing section 1907 of the Charter and substituting a new section 1907 therefor.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ERIE COUNTY LEGISLATURE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1907 of Article XIX of Local Law No. 1-1959, constituting the Erie County Charter, as amended, is hereby repealed, and a new section 1907 is substituted therefor to read as follows:

Section 1907. Charter Revision Commission. The County Legislature shall create a charter revision commission in March 1980. The Commission shall study the operation of the County to determine whether the Charter and Code continue to be an effective framework for the County government and shall submit a final report, including recommendations for appropriate action, to the Legislature by March 1 of the year following its creation.

The Commission shall be provided with adequate funding for staff and costs as deemed necessary by the Legislature.

The Commission shall have 27 members: one member to be appointed by each district Legislator, two members to represent the Legislature, and five members to be appointed by the County Executive.

The Legislature shall act on the recommendations, either approving or disapproving each recommendation separately, within three months of the date of submission.

Section 2. This law will take effect immediately.
