LOCAL LAW INTRO NO. 11 - 1984

A LOCAL LAW amending local law no. 6-1980 to allow the Commissioner of Parks and Recreation to regulate and prohibit the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages within Erie County parks by special rule.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ERIE COUNTY LEGISLATURE, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 14 of Local Law No. 6-1980 adopted by the Erie County Legislature on May 15, 1980, and signed by the Erie County Executive on June 6, 1980, is hereby amended to read as follows:

§14. Alcoholic Beverages. It shall be unlawful for any person

(a) To possess or consume any alcoholic beverage in a park, except beer, ale or wine. The possession and consumption of beer, ale or wine in Erie County parks may be regulated or prohibited in such degree and manner and in such parks or park or portion thereof as shall be determined from time to time by the Commissioner of Parks and Recreation by Special Rule promulgated in accordance with Section 21 hereof.

(b) To consume any alcoholic beverage, including beer, ale and wine, or to carry any open alcoholic beverage container, in any moving vehicle in a park.

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
