THE ERIE COUNTY LEGISLATURE DOES ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Purposes.

This legislature finds that Erie County does not have sufficient personnel and resources to administer and enforce the Uniform Code. As such, pursuant to Section 381 of the Executive Law, this legislature shall exercise the county's option to decline the responsibility of administering and enforcing the Uniform Code.

Section 2. Effective Date.

This local law shall be effective immediately.
