Local Law No. 3 of the year 19 96

A local law amending Erie County Local Law Number 8 of 1984 regarding the establishment (Insert Title) of the downtown pedestrian/transit mall special district in the City of Buffalo.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF ERIE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 9 of Erie county local law 8 of 1984 is hereby amended to read as follows:

In the event that the County shall contract with a not-for-profit corporation pursuant to Section 5 of Chapter 673 of the Laws of 1983 of the State of New York, the County shall only contract with such corporation if such corporation's certificate of incorporation or by-laws provides for the following ratio of representatives on its board of directors:

Eight (8) directors chosen by owners of the real property within the district elected by vote weighted in proportion to the burden of special district charges;

The County Executive or the Deputy County Executive or a commissioner of a County department designated by the County Executive;

A tenant within the special district appointed by the County Executive;

The Mayor of the City of Buffalo;

A tenant within the special district appointed by the Mayor of the City of Buffalo;

The City of Buffalo Ellicott District Common Council member or a designee

jointly approved by the Ellicott District Common Council member and the President of the Common Council, selected from the at-large members of the Common Council;

The Legislator of the County of Erie within whose legislative district the mall district lies or a designee jointly approved by the Legislator within whose legislative district the mall district lies and the Chairman of the Legislature chosen from among the members of the Legislature;

The chairman of the Niagara Frontier Transportation Authority or a designee of the chairman chosen from among the members of the board of commissioners of the Niagara Frontier Transportation Authority.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.




