I. Welcome by Chair Betty Jean Grant

Questions/Discussion:

Betty Jean Grant: When Sheriff helicopter assists other counties, are we reimbursed?

Dr. Callan: No, but the County Executive can't control the Sheriff's budget according to the County Charter. According to Article 25, Section 2507(a), if one or more of independently-elected officials becomes aware of a deficit, he or she shall notify Legislature so immediate action can be taken.

Michael McFarlane: Does Sheriff's budget compound every year if he goes over it?

Dr. Callan: Sheriff's budget increases every year, but he still goes over budget by millions of dollars. Jail management is our biggest out of control problem in county government.

Scott Bylewski: Perhaps the Commission can amend local law to require the budget monitoring reports monthly.

Michael McFarlane: How much of \$360 million from state and federal governments are for mandated expenses?

Dr. Callan: Most of it. Some programs are not mandated, but the county pays for it and is reimbursed by state and federal funds.
