

FINAL REPORT

CONSOLIDATION FUNDING

KENMORE AVENUE - CITY OF BUFFALO

A resolution submitted to the County Legislators for Erie County to fund \$400,000 to the City of Buffalo for paving of Kenmore Avenue, (CR 307) was approved by the Legislature on August 13, 1997, (Resolution 16-2). This resolution authorizes the County to contribute up to \$400,000 towards the total project cost of \$500,000 for milling and overlay of the south side of Kenmore Avenue from Military Road to Main Street.

The City of Buffalo has satisfactorily completed the overlay paving of Kenmore Avenue from Military Road to Main Street.

We have made an on site inspection of the work and have ascertained that it is now complete.

Mr. Joseph N. Giambra, Commissioner for the City of Buffalo, has requested payment of the County's share in the amount of \$258,506.23 and has provided documentation that the City paid the Contractor for the County portion.

We have processed this request for final payment.

WHEREAS, on June 26, 1997, the County Legislature unanimously approved a resolution calling for a municipal cooperation agreement, between Erie County and the City of Buffalo, for the purposes of coordinating any and all future Kenmore Avenue road repair, and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned resolution also calls on County and City Public Works Department officials to develop a plan for the eventual consolidation of Kenmore Avenue into one of the aforementioned municipalities, and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature has determined that a consolidation of Kenmore Avenue with either Erie County or the City of Buffalo would have many advantages, including:

Provide for the public safety as Kenmore Avenue would be maintained and repaired in a consistent manner, thereby providing for a smooth and safe road surface

Eliminate duplicative road maintenance efforts, thereby providing for greater efficiency and effectiveness in the use of public appropriations

Would address a historical disparity as Erie County maintains several town roads, and does not currently maintain and repair any roads located within the City of Buffalo

and

WHEREAS, the County Municipal Consolidation Committee issued its report on April 17, 1997, recommending that \$920,000 of 1997 county budget funding, be used for the maintenance of certain Streets with joint county/city ownership, and

WHEREAS, Kenmore Avenue is one of five streets listed in said report that meets the criterion of having joint county/city ownership, and

WHEREAS, while the north side of Kenmore Avenue, currently under Erie County's jurisdiction, is in generally good condition, the south side of Kenmore Avenue, currently under the City of Buffalo's jurisdiction, is imminently in need of repair work, and

WHEREAS, County Public Works officials have estimated that road work, including a 3" mill and surface overlay, for approximately five (5) miles of the south side of Kenmore Avenue, from Military Road to Main Street, will cost approximately \$500,000, and

WHEREAS, the City of Buffalo has budgeted \$100,000 for Kenmore Avenue and are this year planning to repave a portion of the south side of Kenmore Avenue, and

WHEREAS, a county contribution of \$400,000 from the 1997 County budget will provide the remaining balance necessary to mill and overlay the entire south side of Kenmore Avenue, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the County Legislature does hereby authorize the use of \$400,000 to be used exclusively for the Kenmore Avenue resurfacing project, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the aforementioned funding for Kenmore Avenue resurfacing come from the Legislature's County/City consolidation Fund, which is found within the 1997 Legislative Contingency (County Contingency DAC: 110923310893) to the Department of Public Works, Capital Highway Fund 420, pending the establishment of a separate account specific to the aforementioned Kenmore Avenue project, which will provide for a 3" mill and surface overlay of Kenmore Avenue, for repair work scheduled between Military Road and Main Street, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Legislature, the Commissioner of Public Works, and the Director of the Division of Budget, management, and Finance be and hereby are authorized to complete any and all paperwork necessary to effectuate this transfer of funds, and be it further
