SUMMARY

The Erie County Legislature is requested to receive and file this communication, which pertains to the Department's approval of Work Order URS-4 with URS Corporation for consultant services in the amount of \$50,355.79.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no fiscal implications to the County's General Fund. The cost of the consultant work covered by this communication will be paid by the Operating Account No.51602 of ECSD No. 3.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

URS will provide a complete evaluation of the Boston Valley pumping station and forcemain.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On November 29, 2007, the Erie County Legislature passed a resolution authorizing five (5) Service Agreements with five (5) different engineering firms. As a condition of the award, the Legislature required the Division of Sewerage Management to notify the Legislature of each Work Order by the Division of Sewerage Management.

The Service Agreements were approved to expedite solutions to engineering and construction problems on small projects or to handle emergency situations. For example, on some projects there is insufficient time or it is economically impractical to prepare an individual Request for Proposal. Examples of such instances would be emergency work or small cost projects.

Accordingly, the Department has approved Work Order URS-6 with URS Corporation in the amount of \$50,355.79 to provide a report for Boston Valley Pumping Station and Forcemain Evaluation.
