Re: Review of Erie County's Six Sigma Program

Dear Mr. Melton:

Pursuant to a request of the Erie County Fiscal Stability Authority, the Erie County Comptroller's Office is commencing a review of Erie County's Six Sigma Program ("Six Sigma") for the period January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2010.

We will select six completed Six Sigma projects. Our objectives of this review will be:

- ✓ To describe each Six Sigma project selected and the project objectives;
- ✓ To determine whether the anticipated goal(s) were achieved;
- ✓ To determine the costs associated with completing the project;
- ✓ To determine how the County of Erie benefitted from the project, through either increased efficiency, waste elimination and/or the amount of cost savings.
- ✓ If we can determine if any additional savings can be obtained from a project, we will describe our findings;
- ✓ If a project has no savings, and we believe that is an error, we will describe our findings.

The team initially assigned to this project will be composed of David Kinda, Chuck Buell, Frank Belliotti, Kim Kajdasz and Judy Paul.
