This Buffalo River Ecological Restoration Master Plan provides a framework for ecological restoration in the Buffalo River and the recovery of the Buffalo River and the Area of Concern (AOC). It has been primarily developed from the information gained from regional stakeholders regarding their recommendations on the potential suitability of sites for habitat restoration within the study area. It is a stakeholder driven, collaborative effort to develop well defined steps for the future ecological restoration of the river.
